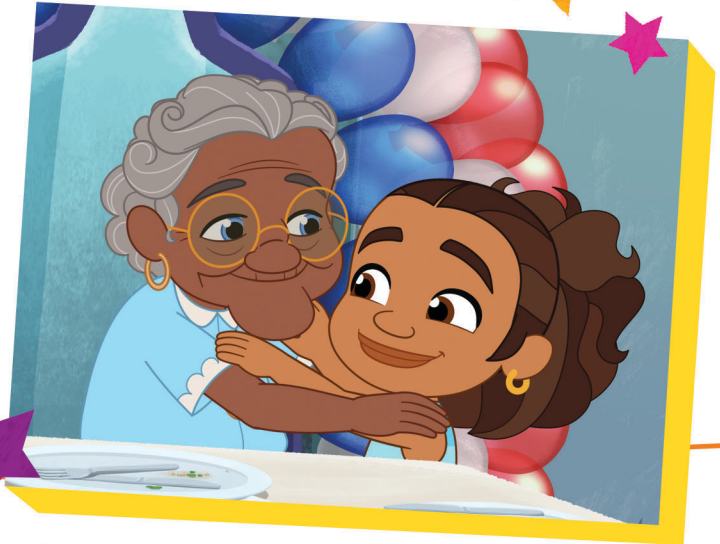


¿Te gusta? Do you like it?
