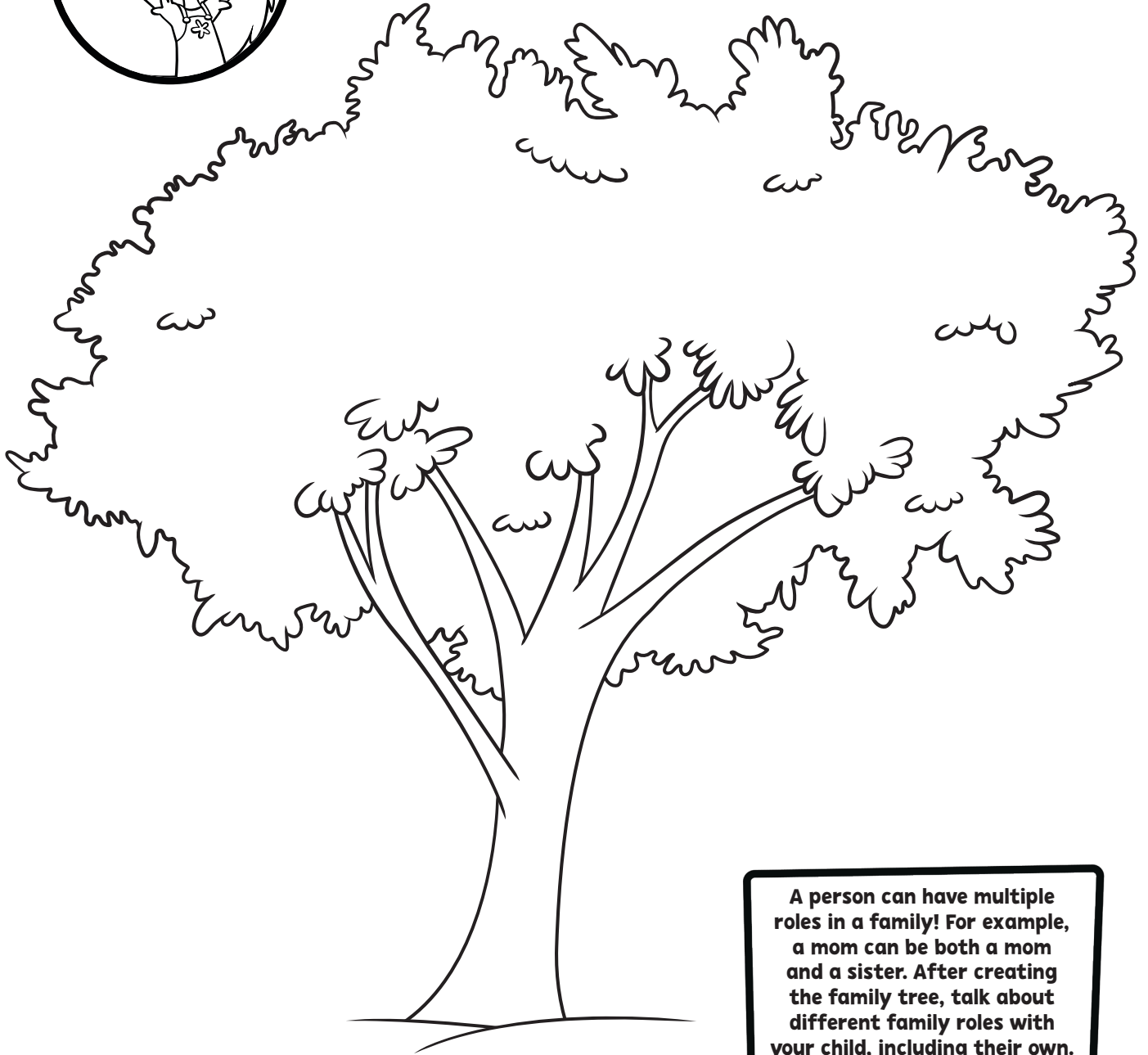
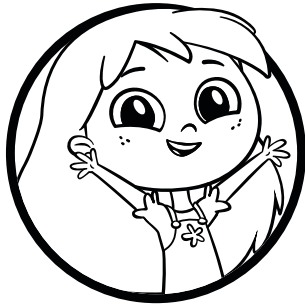




Family Tree
