What you'll need:

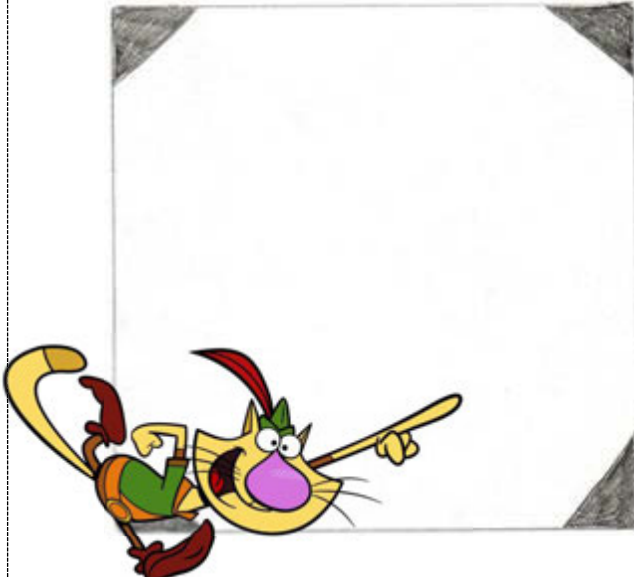
- Binoculars

You may wish to bring:

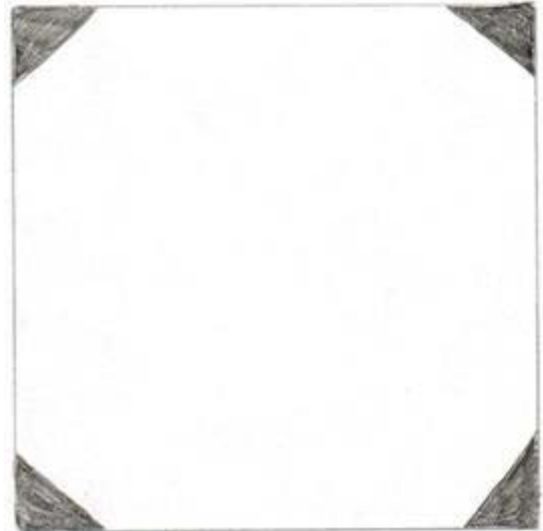
- Camera

Tips for watching birds:

- Never touch or get too close to wild birds (even small ones in your neighborhood)!
- Be patient, slow, and quiet so you don't scare the birds away.
- Try different seasons and times of day. Some birds only come out at dawn, dusk, or at night.
- Leave your pet at home. Dogs, cats, and other pets may chase or scare birds.
- Only walk on other people's property if you have their permission.

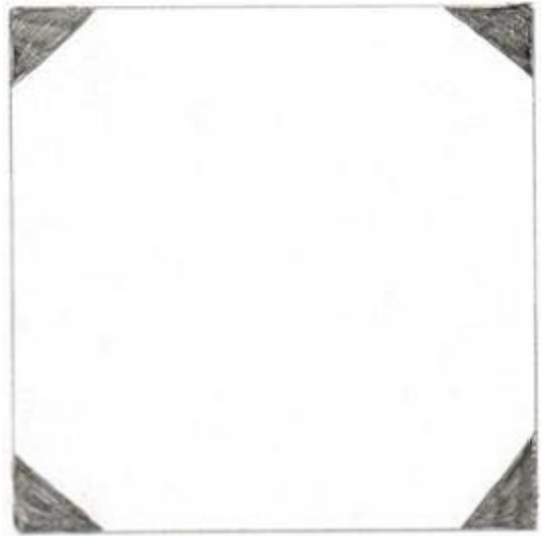

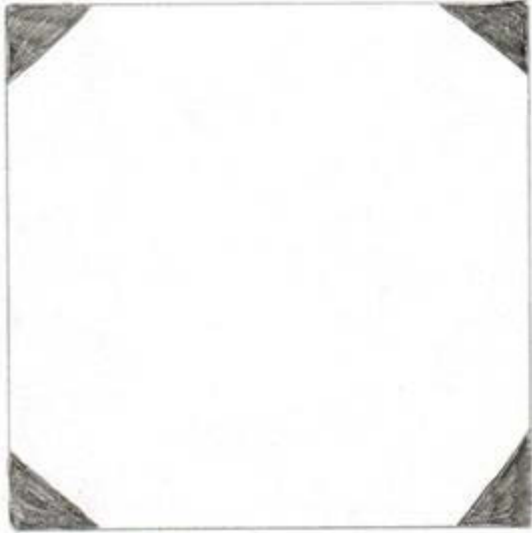

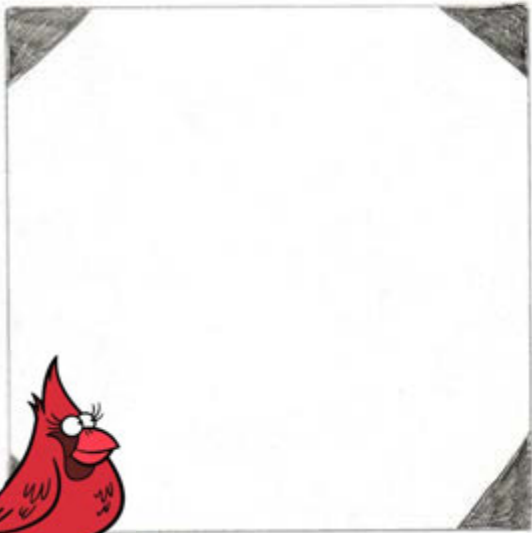
