



Dice Roll Record Sheet

This activity works best with two people. One person will roll a pair of dice while the other records the data. The person that rolls the dice will add them together and that sum will be recorded with a tally mark in the box. For example, if you roll a 3 and a 2, put the tally mark in the box next to the 5. Keep tally marks in neat rows and make your 5th tally across a group of 4 to form a “bundle” of 5. Roll 10 times then switch tasks so that each person has a turn at rolling the dice and recording the data. Try to do at least 60 rolls all together.
