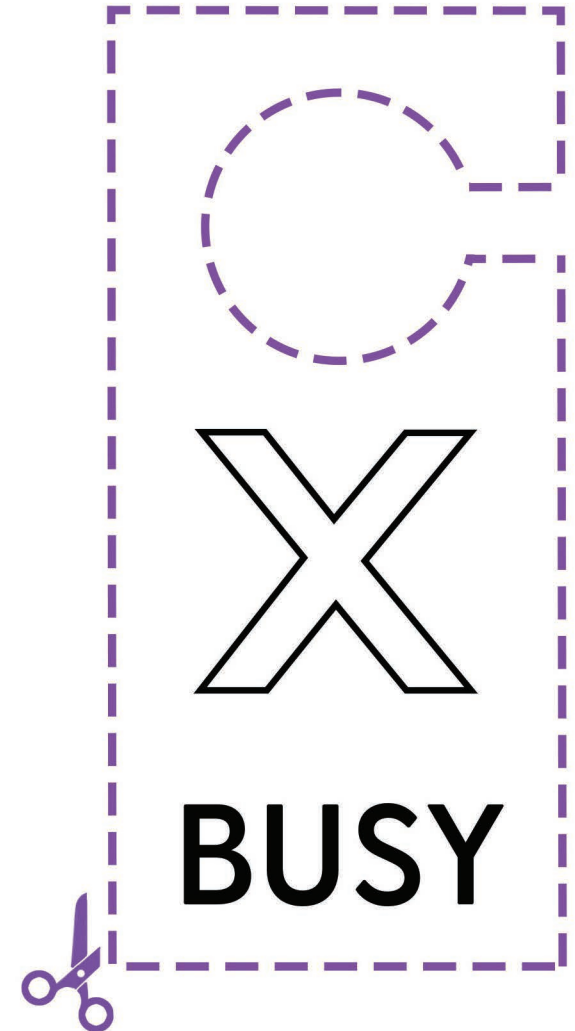
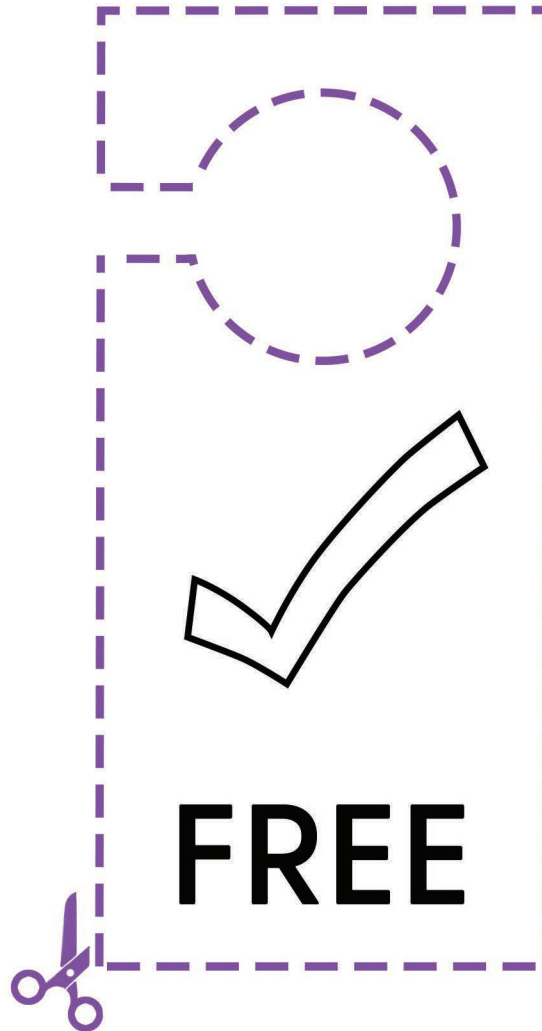




MAKE A DOOR FLIP SIGN!

Phoebe and Jay use a door sign to let friends and family know when they are "free" and ready to play or when they are "busy" and taking time to rest. They use colors to help! Green colors often mean "Go" like a green light, and red colors often mean "Stop" like a stop sign. Use these colors to make a flip sign to tell others what time it is —play time or quiet time!

1. **COLOR** the checkmark **green** and the X **red**
2. Ask your grown up to **CUT** on the **dotted lines**
3. **GLUE** or **TAPE** the pieces **back-to-back**
