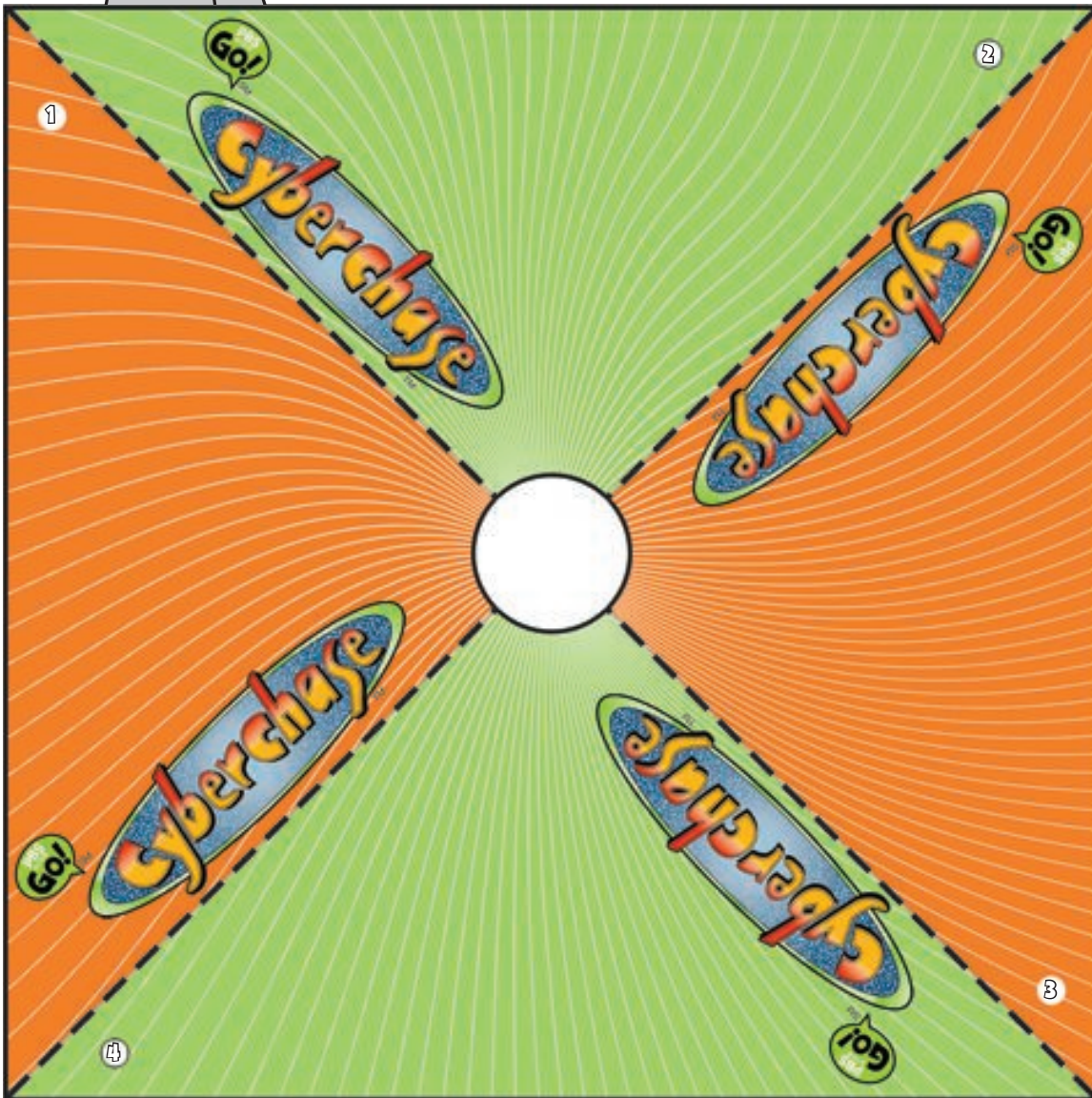


Make a Pinwheel

How windy is it? Use this pinwheel to find out!

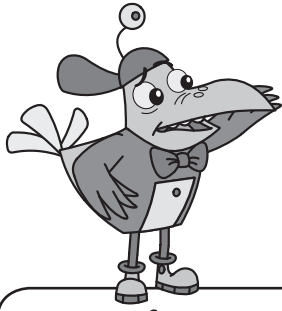

Materials

- scissors
- pencil with eraser
- pushpin or thumbtack

Directions

- 1** Cut out the pinwheel on the solid lines. Then cut along the dotted lines. DO NOT cut into the center circle.
- 2** Roll the numbered corners to the center in order from 1 to 4.
- 3** Ask a grownup to help you press the pushpin or thumbtack through the corners into the pencil eraser. Don't push it tightly, or the pinwheel won't turn.
- 4** Hold your pinwheel sideways into the wind. How fast does it spin? How could you make it spin faster?
